- Hope United Methodist Church is under no obligation to contribute financially to the capital development of the new faith community. Hope's role will be strictly limited to the continued financial support of Pastor Stephanie as the full time Pastor of Discipleship.
- The <u>Rocky Mountain Conference of the United Methodist Church</u> is offering substantial support to the new faith community including:
 - 1. Utilization of the 9.7 acres of property in Aurora, CO.
 - 2. Financial resources for capital development just under \$300,000.
 - 3. Access to funds for ongoing training and consultation for Pastor Stephanie and Hope Church.
 - 4. Administrative services including:
 - a. The Conference will oversee financial transactions for The Land.
 - b. The Conference has extended their non-profit status to The Land Faith Community.
 - c. The Conference will continue to provide insurance coverage over the property through Church Mutual.
 - d. The Conference will continue to provide ongoing legal consultation through Conference Chancellor, Richard Marsh.
 - e. The New Church Development Committee of The Rocky Mountain Conference will provide a structure for ongoing accountability for the pastoral leadership at The Land including such requirements as quarterly reports highlighting progress on established benchmarks, individual professional church plant coaching, and participation in a clergy accountability group for New Church Start pastors.
