Dear Parents,

We are off and running at Hope Parent's Day Out and Preschool! The children are adjusting to the school day and their new schedules. It is delightful to see them moving from one activity to another and hearing their joyful voices throughout the hallways.

A huge thank you to the volunteer parents who have been staying to help make the transition smoother for the little ones! Your help is invaluable.

We also thank you for attending our Back to School Night. The staff always enjoys this opportunity to meet with you, and hopefully ease the transition into school, and your comfort level in leaving your children in our care.

Our newsletters are jam packed with information. We always list the Emergency volunteers for this month, and the following month. We are excited about using Sign Up Genius for our Emergency Volunteer sign up. You will receive a reminder email from Sign Up Genius a few days before your day, and a list of monthly volunteers in our newsletter. If it is your day to be our emergency parent, please come and check into the office that morning. Remember to keep your calendar open for the day. We greatly appreciate your help.

Did you know that we have fire drills each month? This helps to keep our children safe so they know what to do in case of an emergency. To build bridges with our community helpers, October 9, 10, 11 and 12th will be filled with visits from Greenwood Village Police and the Fire Fighters. While seeing their vehicles is exciting, the children also learn what to do in an emergency, and learn that these community workers are here to help us. We also have Tornado Drills and Lockdown Drills each month.

Did you know that 15 hours of In-Service training are required annually for all who work in early education? On Friday, October 6th, Hope will be closed so that staff can attend a full day of classes and training. It is wonderful way for us to keep on top of new ideas and become better-informed educators.

- Please remember that we follow the Cherry Creek School District for holidays and school closure days. If Cherry Creek Schools are closed, so are we. If they are on a delay, we still start at 9:00. (With the exception of our one in-service day on Oct 6th.)
- You are probably receiving your monthly Scholastic Book Orders. We know that reading to your child is the best way to promote literacy, and we feel that Scholastic provides an excellent product at a fair price. We are able to acquire many books and books on CD with the bonus points we receive from your purchases. Thank you for supporting us with your orders!
- If you haven't purchased your King Soopers Reloadable Gift Card yet, now is the time. You pay \$5.00 for this card which then has a \$5.00 credit at King Soopers on it. Before shopping, just go to the front desk and "load" any amount you want, or have the cashier re-load your card before you begin checking out. You may use a credit card, check or cash. Hope always receives 5% of any money you load on your King Soopers card, so this is the card that keeps on giving. Some people load by the trip, and others budget their monthly groceries with the card. Stop by the office and pick one up!
- Please remember to sign your child in and out with your full signature. Initials do not satisfy the state on these papers which are legal documents. Thank you!
- Please remember that school hours are 9:00-1:00 each day. Please do not leave your child in their classroom until the teacher is in the room. Thank you!
- As you take your child to the doctor and get immunizations, please remember to bring Courtney an updated, signed copy. That keeps our files up to date and is very helpful!
- The healthy lunches and snacks that we are seeing are wonderful thank you so much! And thank you for bringing those full water bottles each day. It is so important for the children to have easy access to water throughout the day.
- We have posted playground rules outside for all to see. We appreciate your help in following these rules when you are outside with your children, as this makes it easier for us to all be consistent. Thank you!
- If you have papers in your child's tote for us, please do be sure to tell us, as we don't check the inside of totes regularly.

Again, we thank you for choosing Hope for your young children's early childhood experience. It is a blessing to work with your beautiful children.

Itsy Bitsy Spider


The itsy bitsy spider crawled up the water spout.
