George Robert Dempsey, resident of Jefferson, Colorado, passed away on September 18, 2023.

George Robert was born July 13, 1945 to Gerald Robert Dempsey and June Gail (Fearing) Dempsey in Beloit, Kansas. On August 14, 1966 George Robert married Janice Eileen Nelson in Goodland, Kansas. Two sons were born to the marriage: Bryan Robert and David Martin. 18 years later they were blessed by a daughter from Japan, Yumi Akasaka.

George Robert attended grade school and high school in Montrose, Kansas. He attended college at Kansas Wesleyan University, obtaining a BA in Elementary Education.

Immediately upon completion of his degree, he joined the Air Force, attending OTS in San Antonio, Texas. He became a 2nd Lieutenant and was sent to Navigator Training at Mather AFB in Rancho Cordova, California. He then went to Bombardier School at Castle AFB in Merced, CA. He was assigned to a B-52 squadron at Dyess AFB in Abilene, Texas.

In February of 1972 he was sent with his squadron to Guam, TDY. Over the next 2 years he flew 300+ missions in South East Asia. When his tour of duty was over, he left the military to spend more time with his family.

He moved with his family to Colorado in January 1974. He loved the mountains, enjoyed adventures 4-wheeling, ATV-ing, and riding snowmobiles.

He initially worked in insurance sales and later in sales of labels, silk-screening, and product identification. In 1982 he started GDI Sales with his spouse.

GDI Sales was sold in 2007 and retirement began. George Robert loved the adventure of travel. He and Janice enjoyed exploring in their remodeled Airstream trailer, flying their airplane, and taking international trips.

George Robert was preceded in death by his parents Gerald and June Dempsey and his brother Douglas Eugene Dempsey (Brigitte). He is survived by his wife Janice Eileen, sons Bryan Robert (Claire), David Martin (Annemarie), daughter Yumi (Takami), and six grandchildren: Rio Sean Sueyoshi, Ian Robert Dempsey, Miles Jacob Dempsey, Samuel David Dempsey, Henry Martin Dempsey, and Hannah Mary Eileen Dempsey. He is also survived by his sister Cheryl Dempsey Suhr (Dan), brother Michael Lynn Dempsey (Linda) and many nieces and nephews.
